

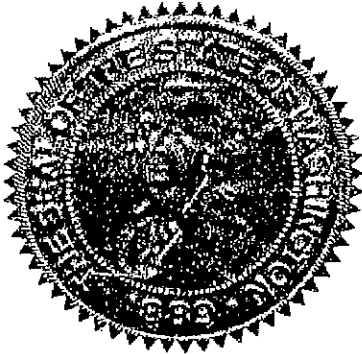


"LAKEWOOD COMMUNITY CLUB"

For the following objects and purposes:-

1. To promote the general welfare of the people residing in the Lakewood District and whose homes and home interests are in Lakewood; to foster, develop and maintain a spirit of friendliness and cooperation between the members of the club; to promote and achieve greater progress in the life of the community; to promote, stimulate and make investigations and reports on matters of public interest pertaining to Lakewood Community and the district immediately adjacent thereto.
2. To sponsor, assist and encourage all forms of social activity and recreation for the members of the club.
3. To secure and disseminate reliable information on important subjects affecting the lives and homes of the members of the club and of all who reside in the district.
4. To maintain and further develop the present club house and grounds; to purchase, lease or otherwise acquire real estate and if necessary or desirable to improve the same by the construction of buildings thereon and to sell, lease, mortgage or otherwise dispose of said real estate and buildings or any part or portion thereof.
5. To purchase, acquire, hold, mortgage, pledge, sell, transfer or in any manner dispose of, goods, wares, merchandise and personal property of every kind and description at wholesale, retail or otherwise when connected with the carrying out on the objects and purposes of the Club.
6. To borrow money for the business of the Club and to give security therefor and in pursuance of said business to issue bonds, indentures, promissory notes or other evidence of indebtedness and to secure the same by mortgage or pledge of all or any part of the property of the corporation.
7. To receive and hold in trust, or otherwise, and to use, in the interest of the Club, all funds and property received by gift or bequest.
8. To do and perform generally all things necessary, proper or convenient to carrying out the objects and purposes of the corporation as hereinbefore enumerated. In addition thereto it shall have all general powers granted to corporations by virtue of the laws of the State of Washington relative to associations for charitable welfare and social purposes.

And have complied with the provisions of the laws of this state in such case made and provided as appears from the certificate of the president, secretary and a majority of the trustees of said corporation, recorded in this office; Now therefor, I. J. GRANT HINKLE, Secretary of the State of Washington, do hereby certify that said Jessie B. Barber, E. E. Rhodes, Albina C. Overton, Jane M. McCloy, Sara J. Colcock, Marcia W. Chetlain, Ethel C. Rhodes, Lena McGorkle, Idella Robb, Benj. L. Randall and Philip J. Weiss their associates and successors, are legally organized and established and are hereby made an existing corporation under the name of "Lakewood Community Club", with the powers, rights and privileges, and subject to the limitations, duties and restrictions which by law appertain thereto.
